POSITION DESCRIPTION

MECHANIC

GENERAL STATE OF DUTIES :

Performs skilled work in the maintenance and repair of all Airport motor vehicles, or related equipment.

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS:

Performs skilled tasks in mechanical repair and maintenance of all Airport automotive equipment which includes a overhead loader and trucks of various classes, snow blowers, runway broom and all mechanical devices, such as overhead doors, pumps, elevators, fence gates, etc. Uses independent judgment as to the method of repair. Reports to Airport Superintendent.

EXAMPLES OF WORK (Illustrative Only) :

Does general overhaul and repair work on all Airport equipment; inspects, adjusts, and replaces necessary parts. In charge of garage area and auto supplies and equipment. Helps in snow removal; recommends to Airport Superintendent what parts are to be bought; keeps all equipment in the ready condition; uses loader and other heavy equipment. Keeps all necessary records, inventories, etc; Acts as member of crash/fire/rescue squad. Trains other personnel on proper operating methods of all equipment. Files reports needed by Airport Management. Responsible for the maintenance garage area. Does related work as required

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS AND ABILITIES.

Good knowledge of standard practices and equipment of the automotive mechanic trade; good knowledge of the operation of gasoline and diesel engines; good knowledge of mechanical repairs; good knowledge of occupational hazards and safety precautions; ability to adapt available tools and repair parts to specific repair problems; skill in the use and care of hand tools employed in motor repair and adjustment work; mechanical aptitude; skill in the use of small electrical tools for mechanical repairs to other than vehicles; good physical condition, honest and trustworthy.
